School Photos

Photos will be taking place during the school day, on Monday the 13th of February. All students will have a class and individual photo taken. (Please note: Year 9 class photos have already taken place.) Photos will be taken by [Photolife](#) and will be available for purchase later in the term. These photos will be printed in the school review at the end of the year and it is important that students wear the correct uniform on the day. Specific information regarding the day and time of the photos will be available to students via the student notices. It is a very busy day and some students may appear in more than one photo. Please encourage your child to take note of where and when they need to be present, it would be a great shame if they were to miss their photo.

Please note: A number of group photos will take place in Term 2. These include Aiga, Whānau, International students, and Kimi ora. Caregivers will be given the opportunity to buy individual photos this term, and the group photos next term.

Cando cards

[Cando cards](#) are produced by Ecardz on behalf of Metro Buses. The card acts as a student identification (providing proof of age/identity) and a metro card but also allows students to access a number of exclusive discounts at retailers and services in the Canterbury area.

Cando cards will be available to order for ALL students for a cost of \$10. On Monday the 13th of February, in the school hall foyer. Students in Years 10 -13 can order their cards during photos. Year 9 students can order their cards during interval or lunch.



On the day students must pay the \$10 (correct change needed) at the time of their class and individual photo using the photo ID card they will be given on the day. Year 9 students can order cards on Monday without their ID card.
