Covid-19 Reminders

As a school we have been fortunate not to have been impacted too greatly by Covid-19 in 2023 but we should continue to be vigilant to ensure the disease does not spread.

The Ministry of Health website states...

From the PTA - Important Information Regarding Second Hand Uniform

Dear Papanui High Whanau

IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING SECOND HAND UNIFORM

Following a review of our Second Hand Uniform processes and systems, the PTA will be moving to a donation based system. This will mean we only sell uniforms that have been donated and will no longer sell uniforms on behalf of whanau.

To transition through to this new system, we will be offering families who have contributed uniforms within the past 3 years (2020 onwards) and have not received a payment, to choose between the following options. As per the terms and conditions of selling uniforms, items that have been in stock for more than 3 years become property of the PTA.

1. Donate

Donate any remaining uniform items to the school - these will be gratefully received with funds raised being given back to the school/students for support with co-curricular activities, prize giving gift certificates, tea and coffee at community events.

2. Collect

Collect your unsold items by completing the required information, please see below. A date to collect uniforms will be notified in due course.

If we have not heard from you by 11 August 2023 we will assume you have decided to donate your unsold uniform.

If you wish to collect your items, please email pta.uniforms@papanui.school.nz

With the following information:

- Your full name
- Your address (where you were living when you brought in the uniform)
- Your cell phone number.
- Uniform items outstanding (eg skirt, kilt, shirt etc)

We require this information in order to return items to the rightful owner. All uniform items held by the PTA have been uniquely coded based on your personal details.

Once we have coordinated all of the items to be returned, families will be informed of the pick up date and time.

Thank you for your support and understanding as we transition to this new system.

We look forward to bringing you second hand uniform sales again in the near future.

Gold - Kumite Female 14/15yr Open


Gold - Kumite Female 14/15yr Premier +60kg


